Why we're here

YMCA is the only provider of supported housing dedicated to young adults aged 18-35 in Milton Keynes. To date we have supported more than 10,000 local young people.

We provide a safe place to live for up to 242 young people across our campus and move-on accommodation.

In addition to housing, we provide practical, emotional and employment support to enable our residents to achieve their full potential.

We guide our residents through a pathway of support



The first stage of our pathway is for young people who have experienced homelessness and provides accommodation for 30 residents with 24-hour support.

The focus at this stage is to improve the health and wellbeing of our residents.

Our next priority is to help our residents find meaningful and sustainable employment. At YMCA MK, we offer a unique, person-centred Employability Programme.

All residents are supported by Employment Coaches to establish and achieve their careers goals.

Once a resident has been in employment for six weeks, they will move into stage three – independent accommodation. This consists of 106 flats and apartments available to rent at a cost that is 20% cheaper than other private rentals in the area.

While living in independent housing, our residents are supported as they prepare to move on from our campus to begin the next chapter in their lives.

Ways to get involved

The need for support from our local business community has never been greater.

- Since the pandemic, our waiting list for housing has **grown by 50%**
- **We rely on donations and grants** to fund our employment, mental health and wellbeing services.

It's essential that we have the resources to meet the increasing needs of young people in our community. There are two ways your organisation can support our critical work.

1. Champion of Young People in MK

We want to work with organisations that can **help us lift young people out of homelessness and into employment**. If you can provide our residents with work experience and/or employment opportunities, you will be recognised as a Champion of Young People in MK.
