Volunteer Qualities:

Do you have a friendly disposition?

What we expect from you:

- Must have a full UK Driving Licence and access to a vehicle.
- Must be available during the hours of 9am-6pm to align with the times of typical doctors' appointments.

You must be 18 or over to apply for this role.

What you can expect from us:

- The opportunity to be a part of a supportive and friendly team.
- An induction training course, covering the practices used by the YMCA MK when working with young people.
- Further training opportunities, tailored to your individual skillset.
- A better understanding of local support services.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- To provide transport from YMCA MK to local health appointments, agreed in advance with the residents' keyworker.
- To be punctual to ensure the resident arrives at their appointment on time.
- To be willing to build positive relationships with residents by listening, empowering and supporting.
- Greeting residents warmly and helping them to feel comfortable for the journey.
- Ensuring appropriate levels of confidentiality are upheld at all times.
- To drive safely, abiding by the law.
- To be willing to provide a copy of your car insurance documents and driving licence for YMCA MK's records.
- To be willing to undergo a DBS check with YMCA MK.
- Keep a record of mileage and parking charges to be reimbursed by YMCA MK.
- To inform your Line Manager of any accidents, illnesses or unforeseen circumstances which may occur during the journey.
